Expunge???

If your child is currently taking a class at CHMS that carries high school credit (French I, Latin I & II, Spanish I, Advanced Band, Algebra I, Art I, Chorus I, Computer Science/IT Fundamentals, Drama I, Teen Living I or Production Technology I), you as a parent have the option of having that grade removed from your child's permanent transcript. Having the grade expunged means your child will not earn the credit associated with the course. Requests to have a grade removed must be received in writing by June 29, 2017. A form for this purpose will be included in the final report card.
